Please pay the appropriate fee online via Schoolgateway if you wish your child to have music lessons, availability is on a first come first served basis. Payment for lessons must be received prior to the lessons commencing. Failure to do so may result in your child's tuition ceasing.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Before requesting a place for your child to have music lessons please read the following:

1. In requesting a place for your child you are confirming that you have read the information provided.
2. You are agreeing to pay in advance for the term for your child's lessons at Schoolgateway
3. You are agreeing to support your child by providing them with a suitable instrument, if applicable, for them to use.
4. You will ensure that your child brings their instrument to school on their lesson day.
5. You will encourage your child to practice regularly at home.
6. You may have to purchase music books as detailed by your child's music teacher.
7. Your child will be informed by their music teacher of their lesson day and time.
8. If your child misses a lesson and it was not their fault i.e. the music teacher was absent, your child was taking part in statutory school examinations or on a school trip the lesson time will be 'made up'. The music teacher will inform your child when he or she can deliver the 'make up' lesson.
9. If your child is absent from school due to e.g. illness, holiday etc. their missed lesson will not be made up by the music teacher concerned.
10. In the event of your child not wanting to continue learning an instrument there will be no refund of the current term's fees.
