Today we have had a special assembly from a Young Climate Warriors' Ambassador who has led a discussion about Climate Change. The interactive assembly helped us to understand, in a positive and age-appropriate way, both some of the issues that our planet is facing and also the need for us to all practise living more sustainably. The children learnt a little ditty "Because we love our planet, we can choose to make some changes, little by little, a little becomes a lot" - please ask them to show you with the hand actions!

Research shows that conversation is one of the easiest and most important tools we can use for tackling climate change. Talking motivates us to take action, increases education and helps reduce eco-anxiety. Please chat to your children about what they have learnt today, how they feel about climate change, what small changes they would like to make and how you can support them at home. Talking and modelling are truly effective and inspirational tools. As the children learned today...'we all need to make changes...little by little, a little becomes a lot!'
