We are building a school culture where children are *Respectful*, *Ready*, *and Safe*. Through "connection before correction," we prioritise relationships and kindness. Calm learning environments, engaging playtimes through OPAL, and programmes like *My Happy Mind* and *MIND* will continue to support children's mental health and wellbeing.

Family Engagement

We know that children thrive when school and home work together. This year we'll be offering more opportunities for parents and carers to join in with learning through events such as Stay and Play, coffee mornings, and family activities. Together, we can ensure that children attend regularly and benefit fully from everything school offers.

Life Skills and Wider Opportunities

Alongside the core curriculum, children will develop important life skills through *Forest School*, *Futures*, and projects like *GROW 10* (financial education). KS2 pupils will also receive CPR training, and all children will take part in online safety learning with the Breck Foundation and more.

Inclusion and Support

We are dedicated to ensuring that every child succeeds. Children with SEND or additional needs will benefit from tailored support, including nurture groups, therapeutic interventions, alternative learning spaces, and specialist programmes such as Equals and Lightning Squad. Our staff will continue professional training in areas such as speech and language, special needs support, and inclusive practice.

Leadership and Growth

Children will have opportunities to take on leadership roles—from sustainability champions to CPR Smart leaders—helping them develop confidence, responsibility, and pride in their contributions to the school community.
