Years 3 to 6	4 hours of work daily	Children should log on to Seesaw in the morning by 9am and complete the work set daily. At least 3 hours of activities a day	1. Maths, English and reading. 2. Science and PE when posted. 3. Topic and other lessons

We understand that for some families the routines may have to vary from the above but it is important that all children log on to seesaw or tapestry daily and maintain a routine to help them cope with the current situation and to ensure they do not fall behind with their learning.
