📖 Reading Adventure

- Who was your favourite character? What makes them interesting?
- What do you think the main message of the story is?
- Would you recommend this book to a friend? Explain your answer.
- Can you predict what might happen next?

You could even **draw or create a comic strip** showing your favourite scene!

🧮 Maths Challenge

Can you become a **Times Tables Champion**? 🏆

Practise your:

- 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- 3, 4 and 8 times tables
- 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12 times tables

★ Extra Challenge:

Can you answer multiplication and division questions without writing anything down?

For example:

$7 \times 8 = ?$

$56 \div 7 = ?$

$9 \times 6 = ?$

$72 \div 8 = ?$

Can you beat your own time?

Creative Writing Adventure

Look out of your window or go on a short walk with an adult. Take a moment to notice what you can see, hear and smell.

Use Your Imagination

Choose one thing you noticed and imagine that it has a secret! 😊

- Is hiding something mysterious.
- Can talk.
- Leads to a secret place.

Write

Use your idea to write **at least one page**. You could write a short story, setting description, poem or diary entry.

★ **Challenge yourself to include:**

- **Expanded noun phrases:** *the enormous, ancient tree*
- **Powerful verbs:** *crept, raced, whispered*
- **Fronted adverbials:** *Suddenly, / In the middle of the night, / Behind the old gate,*
- **A simile:** *as quiet as a mouse*
- **Interesting sentence starters**

Story Starter

"I had never noticed it before. Hidden behind the..."

Remember, you can use your imagination even if you cannot go outside! 😊
